

# **5DAYS 4 NIGHTS IN JORDAN**

#### Day 1: Arrival to Amman

- Arrive at Queen Alia International Airport (QAIA)
- Transfer to your hotel in Amman
- Explore Amman: if arriving at morning time
  - o Rainbow Street (cafés, street food, and vibrant atmosphere)
  - The Citadel & Roman Theatre (historical sites with city views)
  - Jordan Museum (Dead Sea Scrolls & Jordan's history)
- Overnight in Amman

# Day 2: AMMAN -PANORAMIC CITY TOUR- BETANY – MADABA – MT. NEBO- Dead Sea-Amman

Breakfast – Meet at the hotel and depart for a panoramic tour of Amman. At the scheduled time, depart for the border with Israel and Palestine, heading towards the Jordan River. This day will be dedicated to visiting one of Jordan's most mystical and spiritual sites. We will visit Bethany, the place where Jesus was baptized by Saint John the Evangelist. The Jordanian site of Bethany was opened to visitors in 2000, and Pope John Paul II attended its inauguration as a sign of recognition by the Vatican. Baptism of Jesus Site "Bethany Beyond the Jordan" (Al-Maghtas) This archaeological site, located on the east bank of the Jordan River, about 9 km north of the Dead Sea, is of immense importance to Christianity because it is recognized as the place where Jesus of Nazareth was baptized by John the Baptist. Continue to Madaba to visit the Orthodox Church of St. George, home to the first mosaic map of Palestine. Continue to Mount Nebo to admire the panoramic view of the Jordan Valley and the Dead Sea from the mountain. This site is significant because it was the last place visited by Moses and from where the prophet glimpsed the Promised Land, which he would never reach., then transfer to the Dead Sea. Spend the afternoon relaxing and floating in the mineral-rich waters of



the Dead Sea, renowned for its therapeutic properties. You can also enjoy a mud bath for a unique spa experience, return to Amman overnight.

## Day 3: AMMAN - JERASH - Shobak Castle - PETRA

Breakfast – Meet at the hotel and depart for visit Jerash, one of the cities of the Decapolis. Jerash is located north of Amman, approximately 45 km and an hour away by road. During the excursion, we will visit the Arc de Triomphe, the oval square, the cardo, the colonnade, the temple of Aphrodite and finally, the Roman theater, with wonderful acoustics. The conservation of the ruins of Jerash is still surprising today, giving us a very accurate idea of what the cities were like at the time. Then visit the Shobak Castle. It's an enchanting castle that was built in 1115 under the rule of King Baldwin I. Shobak Castle is particularly striking due to its remote location in the desert which will make visitors feel a world away from home. Within the castle grounds, visitors can explore the churches, historic ruins, and a secret passageway that leads to a charming spring. The castle also boasts a watchtower, catacombs and a number of Christian carvings and Islamic tablets. Then Transfer to Petra overnight stay at the hotel.



## Day 4: LITTLE PETRA - PETRA - WADI RUM

Breakfast, and departure to the nearby town of Al BEIDA, also known as LITTLE PETRA. Visit of this caravanserais. Back to Petra. Day dedicated to the visit of the pink city, the capital of the Nabateans. During the visit, we will get to know the most important and representative monuments carved in the rock by the Nabateans. We start with The Treasury, a famous and internationally known monument made into a film in one of the Indiana Jones movies, the Colored Tombs, the Royal Tombs, the Monastery... Petra is one of those places in the world where at least there are to go once in lifetime. Then transfer to Wadi Rum Dinner and Overnight.

# Day 5: WADI RUM VISIT - Transfer to Amman airport

After breakfast, starting the visit which lasts two hours, and is carried out in peculiar 4 x 4 vehicles driven by Bedouins, (6 people per car) it consists of a small incursion into the lunar landscape of this desert. On our walk we will observe the wonders that nature has done and the erosion of rocks and sand. At the end of the visit, continuation to QAIA
